This year's themes of "All About

the Water", "Hula Girl at Heart", and "Carnival" brought out a host of creativityly costumed crazies adding to the festivities. As usual, the competition was fierce. First Place Hula Girl at Heart went to Jason Holland (aka our Vice President). First Place Carnival went to Julie Fulton and first place All About the Water went to James Hicks (aka the Prez).
